Summary of Admissions Policy and Procedures

Pre-Prep

Children are admitted into Reception in the Autumn Term of the school year in which they turn five. Offers of places are made on a first-come first-served basis, taking into account the desire to achieve a balanced intake of girls and boys and a mix of birth dates within the academic year, as well as sibling priority. Occasional places may be available.

Prep and Senior

Entry to the Prep is automatic for pupils from the Pre-Prep. We do not prepare children for 7+ or 8+ entry to other prep schools. Entry to Fulham Senior is in turn automatically available for pupils from the Prep.

External applicants to join from ages 7, 8, 11 and 13 (school years 3,4, 7 and 9) must register by 31 October in the year prior to September entry. All registered candidates complete a process of assessment and interview by the January of the school year before they start. The process is designed to help us maintain a balanced cohort with a diverse mix of abilities. Academic ability is one element and helps to inform the support we offer successful applicants but in line with our inclusive approach children are not selected on purely academic grounds. Non-academic abilities and aptitudes are given significant weight in the process. Occasional places may be available.

Siblings and Equality of Opportunity

Siblings of children currently being educated at the school are given priority subject to the availability of places. A 10% discount is applied to fees while the oldest child remains in the School. In line with the Equality Act 2010 and our own passionate belief in equality of opportunity, Fulham welcomes applications from pupils of all social and cultural backgrounds, regardless of ethnicity, religion, home language, family background, disability or other attributes.

Registration and Deposits

A non-refundable fee of £100 per child is payable at time of registration (note that registration does not guarantee a place). Extra charges may apply to overseas applicants to cover bank transfer fees. Acceptance of offers must be confirmed with a deposit of £2,000 per child and signed acceptance of the terms and conditions. Deposits will be returned at the end of the final term of attendance at the School, subject to a term's notice and after the deduction of any monies owed. New parents should note that if they decide not to take up a place which they have already accepted they will be liable for a term's fees in lieu of notice. Notice must be received in writing no later than the first day of each term.

Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) and Medical Conditions

It is a condition of entry that parents provide the School with full details of any SEND before offers are confirmed at the Pre-Prep and before assessment at Prep and Senior. Any medical condition, health problem, or behavioural, emotional and social difficulty should also be declared. All children with SEND and medical needs will be considered on an equal footing with other applicants provided that the School feels able to adequately support the child's needs.

Non EEC Nationals and EAL

Non EEC nationals must provide evidence of entry visas and right to reside in the UK according to UK Border Authority Regulations. Children whose first language is not English may be required to take an EAL test via UKiset prior to assessment.

Fees

Fees are reviewed annually and published before the end of the Spring Term. Additional charges apply for lunches, some school trips and bus routes, and additional one-to-one SEND tuition. Fees are payable on or before the first day of term. For children entering Reception fees are payable on or before 15 June prior to September entry.
